

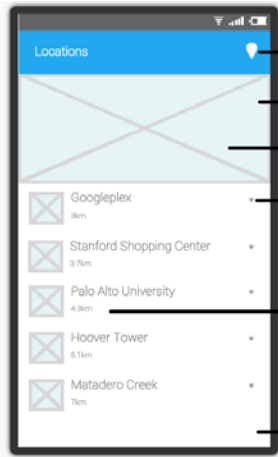
Wireframes Submission Criteria

All participating teams are required to submit their wireframes in PDF format which should include the following details:

- Screen identifier - use format SRNxx
 - e.g. SRN01, SRN02
- Purpose of the screen
- What operations can the user do on this screen
 - each operation should be identified by unique id OPRxx
 - e.g. OPR01, OPR02
- Main views and their purpose
 - List of views, their IDs and purpose
- Action associated with each interactive element on the screen
 - list clickable views and their purpose
- Navigation
 - from
 - to
- Validations on the user input
 - e.g. data length =12 , format = (dd/mm/yyyy)

The wireframes need to be as detailed as possible, explaining the functional flow and user experience in each wireframe.

An example of a wireframe and explanation is given below. Submission along these lines can be made.



Tapping this icon fetches the user's current location

Tapping the Map view expands it to fill the screen and collapses the list

The expand button expands that list item with its details, pushing the subsequent list items downwards

List items are populated by addresses close to the selected location and sorted by their proximity to it

The list is scrollable with a constrained height, which is calculated after collapsing the map with a constant aspect ratio

Tapping any address on the map adds a pin and collapses the map to a fixed aspect ratio, bringing up the list with the tapped address on top and nearby addresses below
